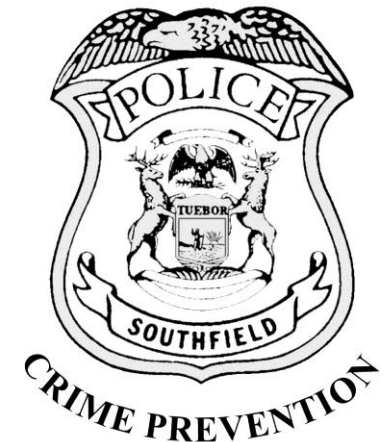

28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy

(Commercial- Restaurant)

Officers were dispatched to 28000 Block of Northwestern Hwy for a report of a shooting. The shooting took place in the parking lot of the restaurant. One victim was shot in the leg and one victim was shot in the foot. Suspect vehicle was a Black Chevrolet Malibu with unknown occupants and left in an unknown direction.

Video surveillance showed victims walk out of the restaurant and stand next to a Silver Ford Fusion in the parking lot. The suspect vehicle (Black Chevy Malibu) entered the parking lot and pulled behind the Fusion. The vehicle then maneuvered so it was positioned pointing towards the exit of parking lot. The driver/suspect exited the vehicle and began shooting at the victims. The suspect got back in his car and fled the scene.

The two victims were located at nearby Hospital.

Both victims were uncooperative with Officers.

Incident is under investigation.

At this time, victims injuries don't appear to be life threatening.

29000 Block of Southfield Rd.

Officers were dispatched to the area of the 29000 Block of Southfield Rd. on a possible abduction / assault. Suspect vehicle was described as a Black Dodge Charger with dent on the right side door, and tinted windows.

Southfield Officer located the vehicle S/B on Southfield Rd. near Jeanette. The vehicle was stopped and a female immediately exited the vehicle and stated she had been abducted and held against her will.

Further investigation revealed that subjects in the vehicle were involved in cashing fraudulent checks and making fraudulent transactions with credit cards at two banks in Southfield.

After the transactions were completed one of the subjects confronted the female's boyfriend and wanted the money from one of the bank transactions. The boyfriend punched subject in the face and fled from the vehicle with the money. The female attempted to flee the vehicle as well. The subjects in the vehicle stopped female from exiting the vehicle. One of the subjects was reaching back from the front passenger seat. Another subject drove the vehicle while the other subject held female, preventing her from leaving.

The female was held against her will until their vehicle was stopped by the Police.

Two subjects were arrested in relationship to this incident.

(Hotel)

Officers were dispatched to Hotel on a report of two people arguing and the sound of gunshots. Officer's arrived and went to hotel room where the gunshots were reported to come from. Officers found no one in the room. There was a spent shell casing and a bullet hole in the wall. The adjacent room was checked and no injuries were found. The bullet was recovered as well as the spent casing. No evidence that anyone may have been injured.

The scene was processed by a Southfield Police Evidence Technician.

Officers checked all the local hospitals for any gunshot victims. None were found at this time.

DWLS/ Possession of Marijuana/ R&O- 3- Arrests

Southfield Rd. & Mount Vernon St.

Southfield Officer stopped vehicle for traffic violations. During the stop, two passengers fled from the vehicle on foot. Officer immediately radioed information in regard to suspects fleeing on foot.

Officer secured the driver and continued his investigation with regard to the driver. The driver was later arrested for DWLS and Possession of Marijuana.

Officers located the two suspects that fled on foot on Maryland St. running through the neighborhood. Officers apprehended one of the suspects immediately.

A citizen pointed in the direction that the other suspect fled.

A Southfield Police K-9 Unit initiated a track and located the third and final suspect running through a yard. K-9 and other Officers cornered the suspect in a residential backyard and he was taken into custody without incident.

## Special Attention: Larceny from Vehicles How to prevent this from happening to you!

-Citizens should never leave anything of value inside their vehicle. (Especially Handguns, Purses, Wallets, Cash & Cell Phones!)

- If you have a garage you should park your vehicle in the garage and lock the garage.

- Wheel Locks are a deterrent but don't leave the wheel lock key in the interior of your vehicle, especially the center console or glove box. This is the first place they will look for the wheel lock.

-After parking your vehicle turn your wheels all the way to the right or the left. This will make it difficult to get the lug nuts off the front wheels.

- If you don't have a garage, try to park your vehicle as close to your residence as possible.

-If you here any loud noises near where your vehicle is parked, especially during the late night or early morning hours, attempt to look outside without alerting anyone and if someone is tampering with your vehicle immediately call 911, (Do Not Approach or Scare the Suspects Away) give Police Dispatchers as much information about the suspect(s) and

## A&B/ Obstruct Police/ Possession of Marijuana/ R&O- 2- Arrests

Dispatch advised that a male victim around the age of 60 was assaulted while walking down the sidewalk. A group of three black males left the location on foot following the assault.

Officers arrived in the area and located a witness who directed them to a nearby apartment complex where three male suspects were located.

The three male suspects were located and advised that they were being investigated for A&B on elderly male.

The victim was brought to the three suspect's location for a drive by "show up". The victim identified all three suspects as being involved and specifically identified the suspect that slapped him upside the head. This suspect was taken into custody for A&B.

A second suspect was taken into custody for R&O/ Obstructing Police and Possession of Marijuana.

The third suspect was released at the scene.

PWID Marijuana/ Possession of Prescription Medication w/o Prescription- 1- Arrest

Northwestern Hwy. & Evergreen Rd.

Officer was on routine patrol and stopped vehicle for Traffic Violations. After approaching vehicle Officer immediately could smell a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle.

The driver stated that he was a medical marijuana card holder and a caregiver. The driver however didn't have his medical marijuana card and had in his possession more than the legal limit. Also in the vehicle was packaging materials, a scale and a prescription pill bottle with no labeling containing suspected Prescription Narcotics.

A Southfield Police Evidence Technician Field Tested the suspected marijuana. The result was positive for possible presence of marijuana. The suspect was arrested for PWID Marijuana and Possession of Prescription Drugs w/o Prescription.
